4.2 The first warning signal will be at 14.00 hours.

5. Sailing Instructions

The course to be sailed will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

8. Scoring System

A minimum of 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the Bendigo Yacht Club.

Competitors participate in the series entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with prior to, during, or after the series.

Each participating boat shall be insured with a minimum cover of \$ 5 million person and property for racing or the equivalent.
